ATTIC Correctional Services, Inc. (ACS) had two substantiated PREA complaints in 2015. The substantiated complaints both involved staff members and in response to the substantiated complaints, ACS developed new training requirements for all employees. These training requirements include: education on what PREA is, as well as ACS' Policy and Procedures regarding PREA, at the time of hire. ACS also requires the completion of PREA and Boundaries Trainings, prior to working alone with residents. Additional training at staff meetings regarding PREA, Boundaries and Ethics, are provided to staff on a quarterly basis. Residents also received education on what PREA is, ACS' Policy and Procedures regarding PREA and services to help victims. By providing training and education to staff and resident, we are committed to providing a safe environment to our residents.
